

Christian Child Care Resources (CCCR) group offers affordable, professional assistance to child and family service agencies within the churches of Christ.

The group is composed of current and former administrators of brotherhood agencies with a total of over two hundred years experience.

How does it work?

The six individuals comprising the CCCR group work as a team.

An interview is conducted in response to each inquiry regarding assistance.

If the Board and administration agree to an on-site assessment, two members of the CCCR team will make the visit.

The two team members will do an evaluation and make preliminary recommendations to the Board and administration.

The two team members will consult with the other members of the group and a contract for services will be originated.

What does it cost?

The agency requesting services reimburses cost of travel, meals, and lodging for the initial visit.

A one-year contract calling for four site visits is recommended. The agency pays travel expenses and a fee for two team members for each visit.

All services will be negotiated and a formal contract entered into.

CCCR will strive to keep cost to a minimum, while providing quality professional services to the agency.

Christian Child Care Resources complements the purposes of Christian Child and Family Services Association, Inc., and is not in competition in any way.

Although CCCR acts independently of CCFSA, it acts with the same concerns for childcare-related work under the auspices of the churches of Christ.
